

2003 FIREGUARD PLAN

1. Philmont will implement the following fire restrictions for the 2003 camping season:
 - No Smoking along trails or trail camps!
 - Smoking is restricted to designated areas:
 CHQ = Advisors Lounge Porch / Staff Lounge Patio
 PTC = East Tent City Pavilion behind staff lounge
 Within vehicles equipped with ashtrays while on paved roads or surfaced roads only
 Designated area at backcountry staffed camps
 - Openfires, including campfires and fireworks, are prohibited
 - Program campfires (base and backcountry) are permitted.
 - Blacksmith Forges and Blackpowder Shooting at designated ranges will be permitted unless otherwise notified.

Notice of fire restriction status will be posted at Dining Hall Kiosk, Welcome Center, Philmont Training Center Bulletin Board and Backcountry Staffed Camps.

2. Rendezvous sites and suggested evacuation routes are identified for all camps.
3. All groups must camp in established sites.
4. Groups must not deviate from their assigned itinerary.
5. All cooking must be done with backpacking stoves in established campsites inside fire rings or on bare earth immediately adjacent. Combustible materials must be removed from a minimum 10' radius surrounding fire rings. A pot of water must be on hand while stove is in use.
6. **The Philmont Fire Department will respond to all fires. SEASONAL STAFF AND/OR PARTICIPANTS WILL NOT FIGHT A FIRE UNLESS IT IS JUST STARTING AND CAN BE QUICKLY EXTINGUISHED. All fires must be reported to Logistics.**
7. How to report a fire:
 - Base camp - dial 911 or Logistics (233, 239, 240). The Philmont Fire Department will provide fire suppression. Seasonal staff may be requested to provide crowd control or other support.
 - Backcountry - Radio Logistics to report a 10-70 (fire), give detailed location and any other available information. The Philmont Fire Department will respond and the Staff in the immediate area and path of fire will begin to evacuate at once. Other camps will hold crews or retrieve crews en route to the area of the fire. **At no time will any seasonal staff member or participants be asked to enter an area in the path of a fire.** Crews reporting fire should proceed to the nearest staffed camp away from the smoke.
8. **What To Do In The Event Of An Evacuation:**
 - Camping Headquarters - the Welcome Center (first) or activities field near Health Lodge (second) will serve as rendezvous points.
 - Training Center - West side Villa lawn (first) or the Chapel (second) will serve as rendezvous points.
 - Backcountry -
 1. Determine all possible evacuation routes upon arrival at camp - **BE PREPARED.**
 2. Gather entire crew and report to evacuation site and follow instructions of staff member.
 3. If necessary, leave packs and gear behind.
 4. Bring:

✓ bandanna (never wet) to filter smoke	✓ flashlight
✓ water bottle	✓ compass / map
✓ jacket or long sleeve shirt (not nylon)	✓ first aid kit
 5. Always travel at right angles to approaching fire, attempt to cross into a burned area after fire front has passed.
 6. When evacuation is complete, check in with staff so all groups can be accounted for.

Participants will be held in rendezvous areas or evacuated, based on condition.
